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- ▶ Takeshi is currently an **Associate Professor** at the **Division of Higher Education Research** at the University of Tsukuba, Japan where he is conducting **quantitative research on higher education policies** in the US & Japan; and **developing an institutional research division**
- ▶ Takeshi brings **~18 years (professional & academic) of rich experience** in quantitative research, institutional research, policy analysis and increasing policy effectiveness in the context of **higher education**
- ▶ Prior to his current role, Takeshi has served as the **Director of Research** at Postsecondary Analytics (USA); Institutional Research Analyst at the University of District of Columbia – Community College (USA); **Director of Research at Tennessee Higher Education Commission** (USA); and Data Analyst at **State Higher Education Executive Officers** (USA)
- ▶ Previously, Takeshi has also served as a postdoctoral scholar at the Golub Capital Social Impact Lab at the Stanford Graduate School of Business (USA) and Senior Research Assistant at the Community College Research Center, Teachers College, Columbia University (USA)

- ▶ Takeshi has **authored multiple public policy reports** and conducted ~25 presentations at professional conferences & meetings
