Dr. Adel A. N. Al-Hussainan is an Associate Professor in the College of Business Administration (CBA) in Kuwait University. He holds a Ph. D. Applied Statistics, with minor in Operations Research from the University of California, Riverside, an M. S. in Statistics, University of California, Riverside, and a B. S. in Statistics, from Kuwait University. He holds a Six Sigma Master Black Belt since May, 2009.

Currently Prof. Al-Hussainan is the General Secretary of the founding board of Abdullah Al-Salem University, Kuwait.

Dr. Al-Hussainan is served as the Vice president for Planning at Kuwait University, 2015-2019. He was the Dean of The CBA for the period from December 2002 to September 2007. He was also the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Center of Excellence in Management at CBA, and was an Executive Committee member at the Kuwait Institute of Business and Technology.

He has assumed different administrative, academic, and professional posts at CBA. He was the Assistant Dean for Research, Consulting, and Training, at the College of Administrative Sciences, September 2000 - 2002, Director of the Center of Excellence in Management Kuwait University, December 1999 – 2003, the Head of the Statistical Consulting Unit, June 1996 – December 2000. He has served on many academic and professional committees at the College and University as well as government organizations.

Dr. Al-Hussainan has successfully lead the complete five years process to acquire the AACSB's (The Association To Advance Collegiate Schools Of Business-International), world wide recognized, academic accreditation for the CBA.
